

All graduating Rio Vista High School Seniors pursuing post high school education are eligible to enter to win a scholarship by writing a 1,000 word essay on The Four-Way Test principals of Rotary International. The Four-Way Test is a set of four questions that all Rotarians are asked to apply in their personal and business dealings and actions to ensure they are ethical and valuable.

Is it the Truth?

Is it fair to all concerned?

Will it build goodwill and better friendships?

Will it be beneficial to all concerned?

Students may either describe how they applied The Four-Way Test principles to an event or experience in their life and how it impacted the outcome, or how they could have applied these principles in a personal experience or event and achieved a different and better outcome.

The winning students will be chosen based on their recognition of the value of ethical actions, as highlighted by the Four-Way Test and described in their essay, along with their overall community service. Applicants may be asked to read their essay at a Rotary breakfast meeting.
