"For the months through December, revenues total \$36,657 which consist of \$16,135 in Club Income, \$3,508 in Service Income, \$1,646 in Scholarship Income, \$150 in Community Service, and \$15,218 in Fundraising Income.

The expenses total \$35,276. The breakdown is as follows: Club expenses were \$18,227, Community Projects of \$2,660, Fundraising expenses of \$10,654, International Expenses of \$1,735, and Scholarship expenses of \$2,000.

To date, the Charitable Fund balance is \$125,000 and the General Fund balance is \$4,730"


