I-Program of the Week's Program Chair:

Gil LaBrie gave a short I-program. He had two majors at CalTech 50 years ago. Engineering and Architecture. He announced himself as an architect engineer.

Program:

Gil LaBrie introduced Jeremiah Leek, the lead engineer for the "Large Erosion Repair Project on the Sacramento River" at his engineering firm. Jeremiah assisted him with the presentation. Gil talked about the levee repair, reconstruction, habitat creation and maintenance work they have done.

It took him 10 years to get all the permits to start the project. One of the biggest challenges is that he is only allowed to work on the river three months a year; August, September and October.

The main part of the presentation is based on the project on Brannan Island between Isleton and Rio Vista. Interesting project with the bags placed in the levee, the riparian portion of the project to the 143,000 tons of rock placed on the levee. Biological studies, permitting. Erosion prevention tactics, tidal and water treatment. A huge and important project. Good luck, Gil!
