Treasurer's Report:

For the months through March, revenues total \$55,557 which consist of \$25,635 in Club Income, \$4,317 in Service Income, \$1,746 in Scholarship Income, \$150 in Community Service, and \$23,708 in Fundraising Income.

The expenses total \$50,779. The breakdown is as follows: Club expenses were \$25,158, \$3,307 for Interact, Community Projects of \$3,660, Fundraising expenses of \$10,819, International Expenses of \$5,335, and Scholarship expenses of \$2,500.

Through March 30th, the Chartible Fund balance is \$180,276 and the General Fund balance is \$6,993. Overdue invoices total \$4,302 and current billing Not Due yet is \$4,222.
