Treasurer's Report: Our Co-Treasurer Alyssa gave the weekly treasurer report.

Hector's monthly treasurer report for the fiscal year thru April 30th is; "For the months through April, revenues total \$63,960 which consist of \$27,448 in Club Income, \$4,548 in Service Income, \$1,746 in Scholarship Income, \$150 in Community Service, and \$30,068 in Fundraising Income. The expenses total \$52,321.

The breakdown is as follows: Club expenses were \$25,618, \$3,592 for Interact, Community Projects of \$3,660, Fundraising expenses of \$11,333, International Expenses of \$5,335, and Scholarship expenses of \$2,782.

Through April 30th, the Charitable Fund balance is \$133,511 and the General Fund balance is \$7,237. Overdue invoices total \$6,132 and current billing Not Due yet is \$3,099."
